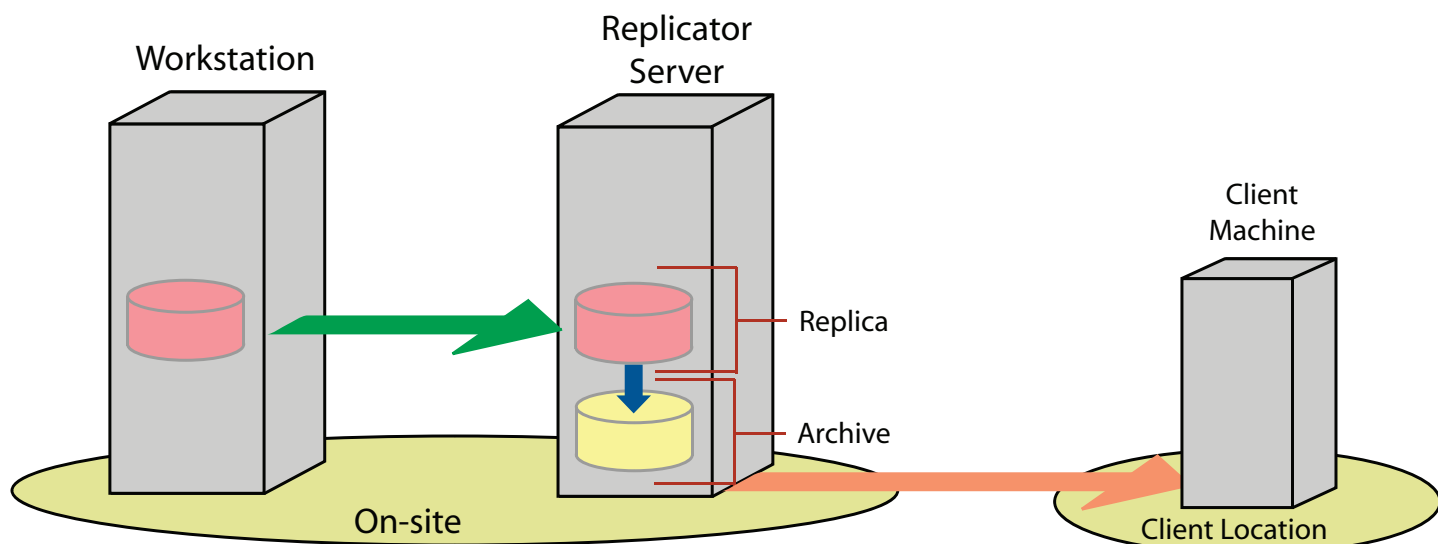


Freelance Environment



The Problem

In a freelance environment, data must be protected and made easily accessible to the client. But it would also be helpful to maintain multiple versions of data to prevent backtracking and provide greater flexibility. Is there one tool that can accomplish all three things?

The Solution

A freelance environment presents a number of problems, all of which are solved effectively using Replicator. First, work must be protected from loss or corruption. Replicator protects data by mirroring it to the Replicator server, where it can be retrieved easily and quickly if something happens to the original. Second, Replicator can maintain multiple versions of data in case clients change their minds. With Replicator's archiving feature, changed versions of data are stored on the Replicator server and are just as easy to recover (through a Web-based interface) as the mirrored data. Finally, the data must be accessible to the client. Data can be made available through Replicator's Web-based interface by providing the client with an appropriate username and password.
