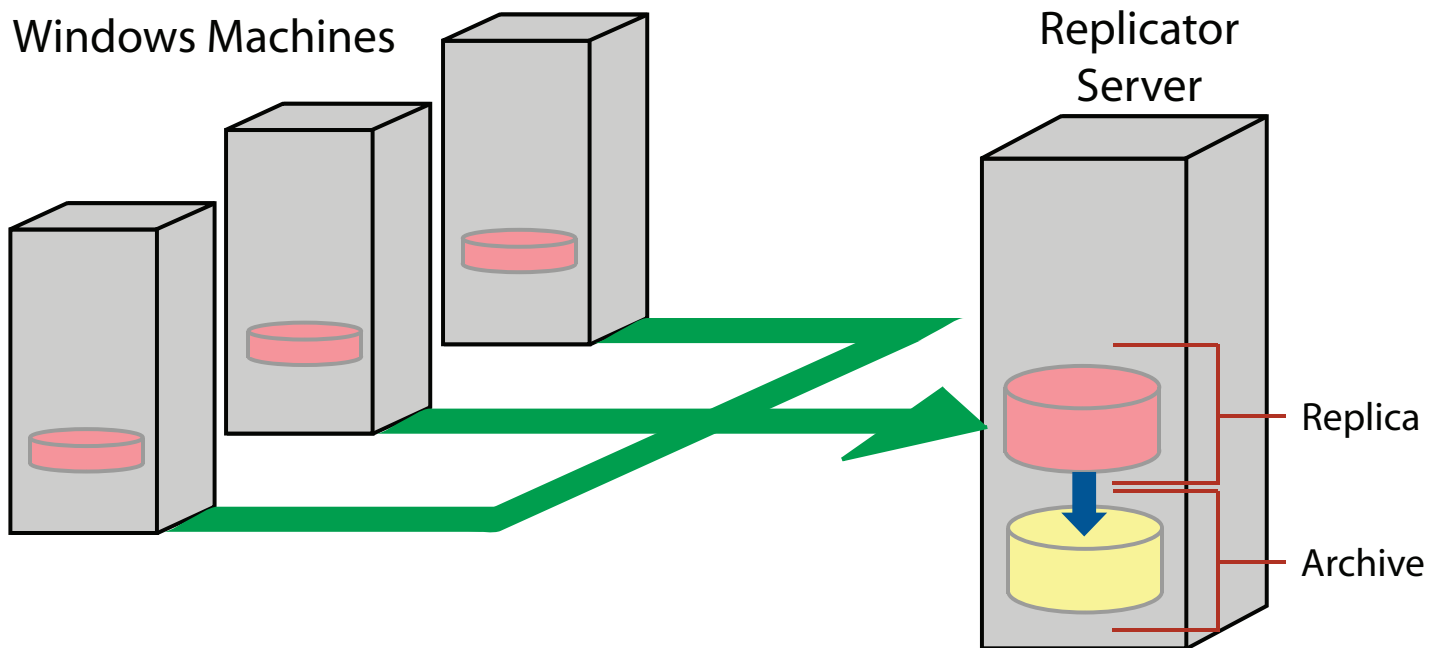


Windows Workplace General Backup and File Tracker



The Problem

What is an affordable and easily administered solution to backing up a Windows-based environment?

The Solution

A Replicator server (running Solaris or Linux) placed in an all Windows environment pulls data from all of the machines on the network at regular intervals, and archives any files that have changed. Using this approach, users on the network can recover files that they accidentally corrupt by simply accessing the Replicator GUI from their favorite browser. This eliminates the need for tedious intra-office backups that normally must be performed by another person in the organization. It also offers the ability to go back in time to look at previous versions of files and restore them with no assistance from a network administrator.
