What is Replicator?

Answer

Replicator is a software module that centralizes the control and management functions associated with the replication of specific directories or files from any server or workstation located within an enterprise. Replicator maintains mirrored copies of data on disk-based storage located in one or more locations. In addition to replication, it is a software tool that maintains historical copies of mirrored data, allowing end users to retrieve either the mirrored or a historical mirrored copy of their data. Replicator replicates data from a variety of UNIX- and Windows-based servers and workstations without the use of everStor supplied client software. Management and end user interface is through a browser-based GUI interface.
